

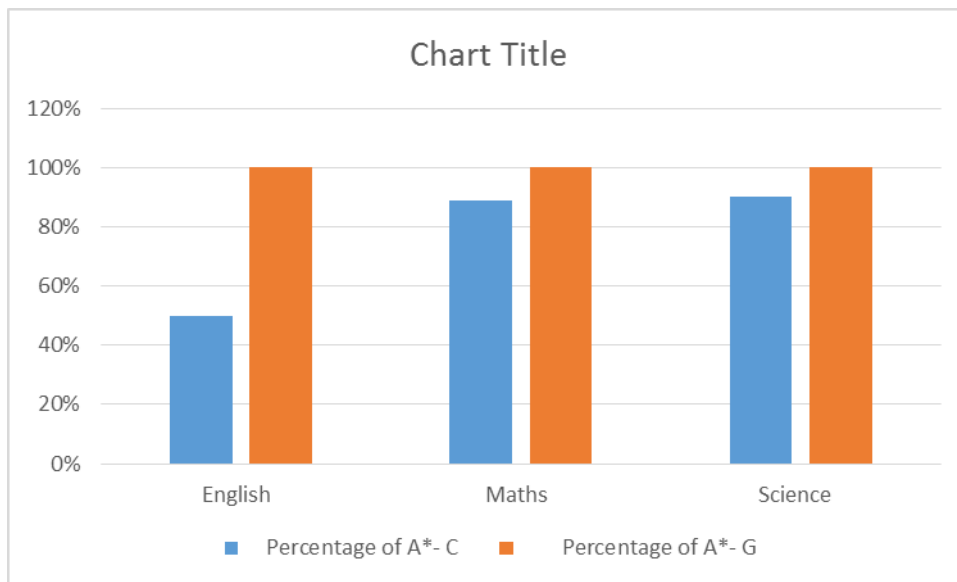
Notes:
