



Exams Report 2021-2022

GCSEs and BTECs

This year, we supported 9 students with 26 GCSE exam entries, 3 BTEC, 1 Signature exam and 2 Functional Skills exams. A total of 71 papers.

Through a mixture of transferring candidates' entries from their home school and our own entries, we have facilitated these students to sit exams despite being in hospital, a feat helping them towards the next stage of their life without a pause in their education.

When some of these students were not able to complete all the papers of an exam, our support and application of special consideration meant that these students were not penalised for their mental health issues and were able to attain results commensurate with their ability.

This year 100% of students passed their GCSEs, that is attaining a grade between 1 and 9.

88% of those GCSEs being 'good passes' ie grades 4-9.

Attainment of grades 4-9 in English was 83%, and in Maths was 66.6%

Notes:

1. *It is important to note that all the above pupils would not have been able to sit their examinations without the intervention of the WHHTS.*
2. *The value of the final outcomes for pupils exceeds normal value added scoring due to the acute nature of their medical/ mental health conditions.*
